

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are downloaded to your browser when you visit a site.

Besides Cookies, our Site may contain electronic images known as web beacons (or single-pixel gifs) that we use to help deliver cookies on our Site, count users who have visited the Site, and deliver content and advertising. We may also include web beacons in our promotional email messages and newsletters to determine whether you open and act on them.
